



From the SumTotal App Marketplace home page, find the integration connector app for **Coursera for Business**.




Hover over the listed **Coursera for Business** app and click **More Info** to navigate to the Coursera app details page.


From the Coursera app details page, click **Sign In To Install** to navigate to the **Login Page**.






Log in to the SumTotal Marketplace. If you do not have an account, please click on the link to create one.

Click **Environment Setup** to specify the environment for which you want to submit the installation request. The **Installation Environment** popup screen appears.




#### On the **Installation Environment** pop up:

Click **Install**. This redirects you to the SumTotal URL entered for installation.






Enter the SumTotal Learning environment credentials.


Upon successful login to the environment, you receive a confirmation message that your installation request has been submitted.




The **App Overview** button allows you to navigate back to the App Details page.

• **Configure Integration** - Enables you to configure the screen for integration.


Click **Configure Integration** to navigate to the **Content Integrations** page under your current working domain. Ensure that you are in the *required domain* to configure the settings.






Click **Continue** to navigate to the **Content Integration** page.

Click **EDIT** alongside the **Coursera for Business** entry to open the Coursera Content Integrations Form Page.






Enter all the required details and then click **Save**.


